1. St. Margaret Mary Alacoque who originated the devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus
2. Old Testament priestly figure, Melchizedek. "You are a priest forever, in the line of Melchizedek" spoken at ordinations
3. Our patron, St. Charles Borromeo, Archbishop of Milan, who encouraged frequent reception of Holy Communion
4. The Wedding Feast of Cana, scene of Our Lord's first miracle, when He changed water into wine
5. Our Lady appeared to St. Bernadette at Lourdes in France, calling sinners to conversion

6. The First Joyful Mystery: The Annunciation
7. The Second Joyful Mystery: The Visitation
8. The Third Joyful Mystery: The Nativity
9. The Fourth Joyful Mystery: The Presentation in the Temple
